

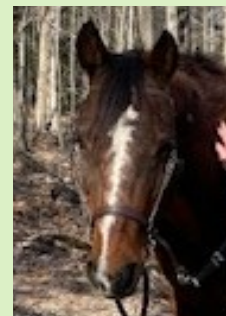


Spring 2025 NEWSLETTER

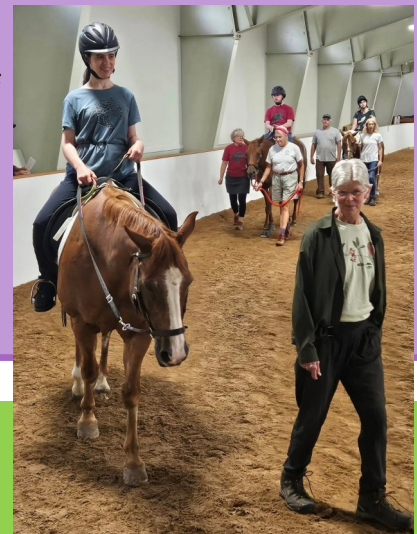
