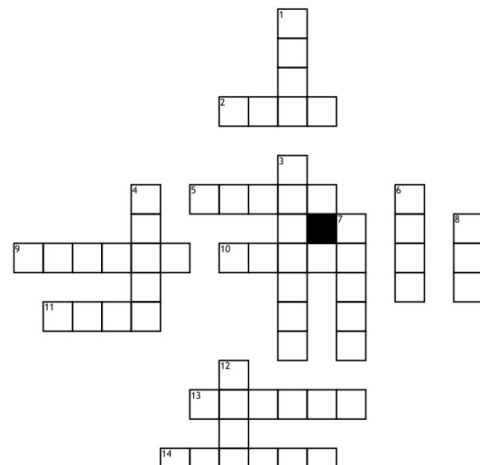
Volunteer Spotlight: Ellen Zaika
